### Information on ACE (Afterschool Child Enrichment) Program

The Ohio Afterschool Child Enrichment (ACE) educational program provides funds for students and families to use on various enrichment and educational activities. including summer camps, tutoring, music lessons, study skill services, and field trips.

#### Here's how it works for parents, guardians, and students:

- Parents and guardians can apply through the Ohio Department of Education for a \$1000 educational savings account to pay for goods to make up for learning loss due to Covid-19. Must meet eligibility requirements.
- 2 Qualifying parents/guardians will receive an email notifying them of their award

Parents/guardians can browse the Ohio ACE Education Marketplace to see relevant approved service providers

#### Eligibility (Must meet one of the three requirements)

- Children ages 6-18 years old
- Residency
  - Live in a district with high chronic absenteeism or has an EdChoice eligible school
- Government Social Programs
  - Medicaid, SNAP, OWF, and other programs
- Household Income
  - Families who are at or below 400% of the Federal Poverty Level
